What Age Do Children Need to be to Attend Preschool?

To attend the 3 year old class your child must be 3 by July 29th. To attend the 4 & 5 year old class your child must be 4 by July 29th.

Is This Preschool State Licensed?

Yes. The Preschool is licensed by the state and has state certified teachers.

What Schedule Do the Children Follow in Attending Preschool?

3 year olds attend preschool on Tuesday's-Thursday's from 9:00-11:30 am.
4 & 5 year olds attend preschool on Monday-Wednesday-Friday 8:30-11:30 am
or Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday-Thursday 12:15-3:00 pm.

Is Transportation Provided?

No. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from school.

What kind of Program is Offered at Holy Cross Preschool?

Holy Cross Preschool is designed to most effectively meet the needs of students. Children are provided with a learning environment that gives them the opportunity to explore, to manipulate, to create, to question, to build esteem and to discover at their own rate.
